#### **ADDITIONAL OWI PENALTIES**

### ALCOHOL ASSESSMENT: (EXCEPT FIRST OFFENSE PAC (346.63(1)(b) .08 and .09))

The Court shall order the person to submit to and comply with an assessment by an approved public treatment facility for examination of the person's use of alcohol, controlled substances or controlled substance analogs and development of a driver safety plan for the person [§343.30(1q)(c)]. If the Court finds that the person is already covered by an assessment or is participating in a driver safety plan or has evidence presented to it by a County Department under §51.42 that the person has recently completed assessment, a driver safety plan or both, the Court is not required to make such an Order.
